Could you support a person to make new friends, develop new interests, broaden their experience of community life and become more independent?

WHY DO FAMILIES NEED A BREAK?

Caring for a child or adult with a learning disability can be demanding and stressful at times. When the Carers get a break they can take time for themselves to relax, spend time with other members of the family.

WHO CAN BECOME A HOME SHARE FAMILY?

Anyone who is caring, energetic and enthusiastic. We welcome all, single or in a relationship, young or old, with or without children. Your home can vary from an apartment to a mansion.

About St. Michael's House

St. Michael's House provides a comprehensive range of services and supports to men, women, and children with intellectual disabilities and their families in 170 locations in the greater Dublin Area. It supports 1,782 people and this has an impact on thousands of family members. St. Michael's House is a company funded by the Health Service Executive (HSE) and the Department of Education and Skills.

We require community support for the people who use our service.

There are different types of Home Sharing Families. Which one will work for you?

HOME SHARING "SHORT BREAKS" FAMILIES

- A Home Sharing Family provides short breaks such as day care breaks, short overnight break, or breaks over holiday periods.
- An allowance is paid per break in line with Tusla Fostering rates. Current rates on www.smh.ie

HOME SHARING "CONTRACT" FAMILIES

 A Home Sharing Family provides significant experience in the caring field and are recruited to provide short break support.

- Contract families are expected to provide a number of short breaks per month.
- An allowance is paid. Current rates on www.smh.ie

HOME SHARING "SHARED LIVING" FAMILIES

- A Home Sharing Family "Shared Living" provides full time care to a person with an intellectual disability, similar to, a fostering placement.
- An allowance is paid. Current rates on www.smh.ie

There is an Assessment Process, Training Support and Financial Support for all Home Sharing Families.
