Who can do this course?

This is a QQI Level 2 course.

This course will support you to learn about gardening.

We can support you with communication, reading and writing.

We will use pictures, symbols and DVDs to help you learn.

You need to enjoy spending time outside.

You should like nature and working with your hands.

Before you apply for the course, check you understand and are happy with:

- The learning goals
- The assessment you will have to do
- The time the course will take.



How long will the course take?

This course will take around 25 class hours.

You will do work in class and some work at home.

This course is worth 5 credits.

The trainer will tell you how many weeks the course will be on for.

The trainer will tell you how long each class will last.

What assessments will I have to do?

The assessment for this course is called a portfolio.

You keep all the work you do on the course in a folder.

This folder shows the information and skills you have learnt on the course.

Your work will be assessed at the end of the course.

This means your folder will be checked.

The people looking at your work decide it is good enough to pass or that you need to do some more work.

Your work will be assessed by:

- Your Trainer
- Another person from St. Michael's House
- A person from QQI



What will I learn on this course?

On this course you will:

- Learn the names of some flowers, trees and shrubs.
- Use different gardening tools and equipment, for example, lawnmower, gardening gloves, rake, spade, trowel.
- Plant a flower or vegetable bed, or a pot of flowers or vegetables.
- Say what helps plants to grow, for example, light, heat, soil, water.
- Explain the four main stages in the life of a plant.
- Understand why the leaf of a plant is important. Say how the leaf helps a plant to grow.
- Show you can work safely in the garden, for example,
 lifting, handwashing, using gloves, storing equipment.
