Family Carers in Ireland

Who Is a Carer?

Someone who provides regular, unpaid personal help for a friend or family member with a long-term illness, health problem or disability



Who Cares? 360,000 or



What's the Kinship **Between Them?**

86% of Family Carers are Family Members. Most are caring for an ageing parent or a child with high support needs.

How Much Care Is Provided?

Average of

hours care provided per week (CSO, 2016) **How Do We Financially Support Full-time Family Carers?**

75,000 carers receive the Carers Allowance.

Over 100,000 receive the Annual Carer Support Grant. (DSP, 2017)

Is the Role Challenging? 50% of carers have had the experience of being mentally and physically 'drained' by their caring role (CAI/ICP, 2009)



What Are the Drivers of III Health in Caring?

Dealing with verbal/emotional abuse: Coping with bizarre/inconsistent behaviour; Getting up in the night. (CAI/ICP, 2009)



What Is the Health Impact?

Over half reported having a medical problem, the most frequent being back injury, and over half also reported having a significant mental health problem, the most frequent being anxiety disorder. Most carers stated that they had no time for themselves and worried how the person they cared for would cope if they had to stop caregiving due to illness or death. (CAI/ICP, 2009)

What's the Gender Mix?

Females provide around two-thirds (66.1%) of all care hours, increasing to approximately seven in ten from age 50. But 40% of Family Carers are male. (CSO, 2012)
