



How to make Paper Mache Mask



You will need



Old Newspapers/magazines



Cup of warm water



Cup of plain flour



1 Balloon



Paint



Scissors








Egg carton



Bowl

Method

Dip the paper strips in the paste



Place pieces of newspaper on to balloon



Cover the balloon with newspaper x4. Leave the balloon to dry



Cut balloon into two

Use empty egg cartons to make the eyes nose and mouth

Glue egg carton pieces on to mask. Then glue paper mache strips over egg carton pieces



Decorate face by painting/colouring it
