everyone safe.

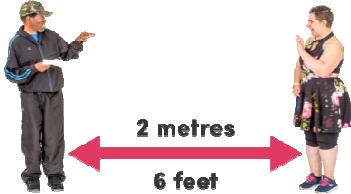


The Person In Charge of

Safe Visiting



Everyone needs to do social distancing for all visits.



Social distancing is difficult for some people.
You can speak to the manager of the house about this.



Visitors need to call the house to arrange a visit.



Staff will tell visitors what they need to do before they visit.



Visitors will have their temperature taken before the visit starts.
Visitors will need to wash their hands or use hand gel before the visit starts.





Safe Visiting



Staff have to wear face masks.



Staff will write down the names of visitors.



Family and friends can visit you in the garden



They can visit you inside once a week.

They can stay for 30 minutes.



People under 16 cannot visit you inside.



Visitors will not be able to meet your housemates.





Safe Visiting



You can meet your family and friends outside.

You can go for a walk, go to the park or the beach.



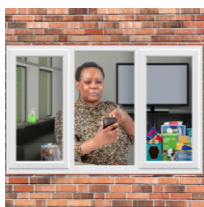
You cannot go in the car with your family or friends.



You can go in a St. Michael's House bus.



If you or someone in your house has Coronavirus, it is not safe to have visitors.



Everyone in the house will need to stay inside.

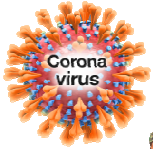


The HSE will tell us when it is safe to have visitors inside again.
