Did you know

The UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities was ratified in March 2018.

This means that there is a legally binding international instrument to guarantee,

for the first time ever, that the State **must** promote and protect the rights of people with disabilities.



Day Centre

Day Supports & Services

•We have 50 Day Supports & Services for 900 adults.

•We have 30 – 40 school leavers each year who seek Day Supports & Services.

Action

Ensure people with Intellectual Disability have access to
 New Day Supports & Services & Transport Services





Residential

- •We have 442 adults who live in Houses supported by our services
- •There is a waiting list of over 200 people for this service with continued changing needs
- •More than 300 people supported in our Day services have a main carer at home over 70 years.

Action

Ensure adequate investment and proper planning by Government on Residential services





Respite

- •We have 18 respite beds for children and adults per night.
- We require more resources to support our 1,300 children, adults and their families who need short breaks
- •Respite beds are filled when we have no residential places

Action

Ensure adequate investment and proper planning by Government on Respite services





Education & Therapy Services

- We manage 6 special national schools
- •There is a waiting list for these schools
- 5 of our 6 schools require a new school premises

Action

Ensure Children with Intellectual Disability have access Education and Therapy Services





Employment

- •There were 551 graduates with QQI level 2 qualifications in the last 4 years
- We want graduates to be supported by employers for work experience and/or employment for these adults

Action

Ensure work places are open and accessible for people who have a disability.





Aging Care

- •As adults age, we forecast 200 potential adults who will need Dementia & End of Life care.
- •We have a 10 bedded Dementia unit to support aging services.

Action

Ensure an older persons services plan for people Aging with Intellectual Disability



Clinical Services



- •There are 900 children and young persons, 950 Adults accessing clinical services
- •There is a substantial waiting lists for all Clinical Services Departments

Ensure adequate investment and proper planning by Government for Clinical services
